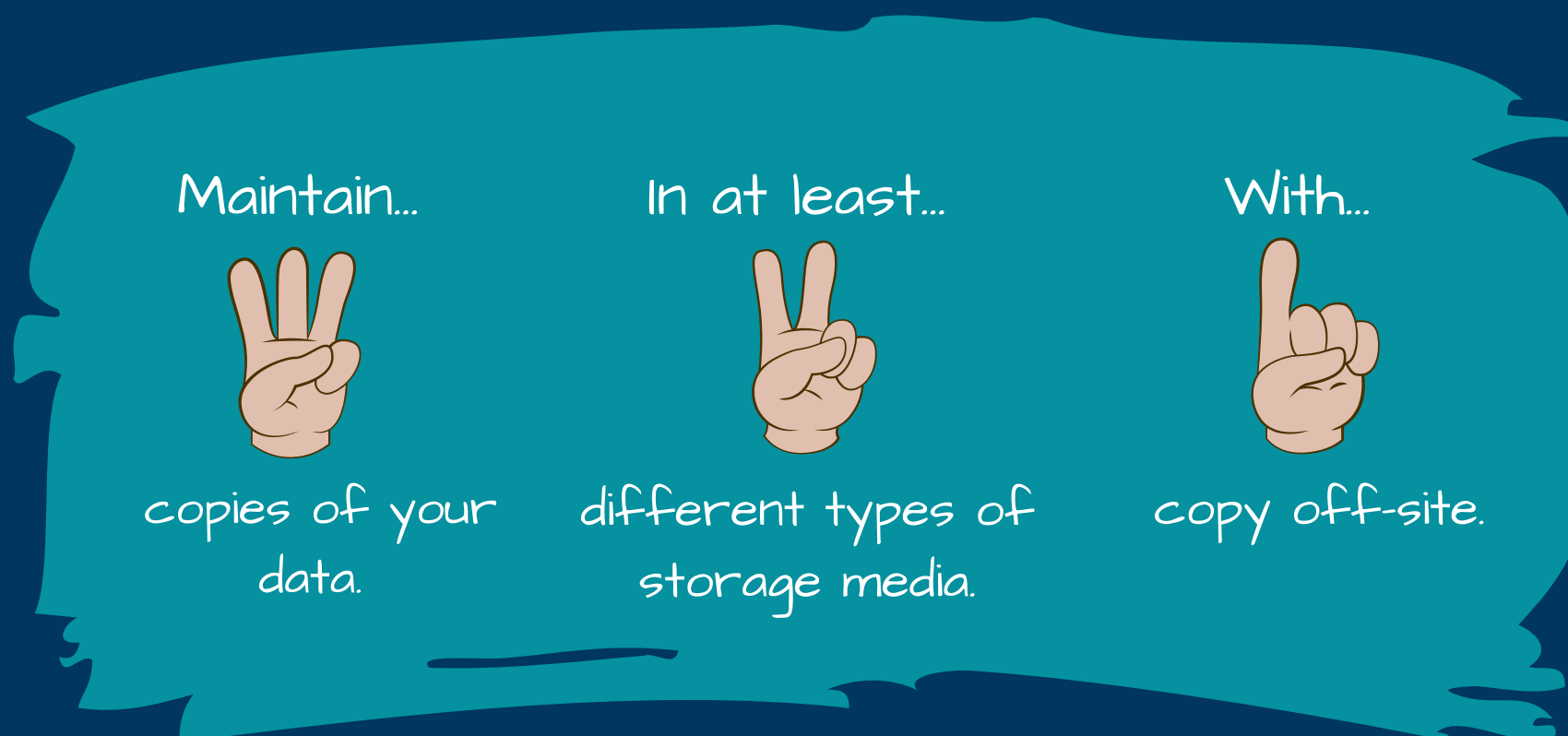


Backup Your Data!

To protect yourself against data loss we suggest you backup your data following the 3-2-1 rule:

OPEN Give preference to open formats

Adopt a file naming and organization convention

Set up a backup routine and auto-sync when available

Use a version control system

Free up space by removing files no longer needed

Always check the terms and conditions governing the storage system

Use encryption and security access measures for sensitive data

Archive final versions in a stable and certified repository
