Perma.cc keeps any links referenced in your research or publications from changing or disappearing. It captures and archives a snapshot in time of the web resources you cite. Perma links won't rot, and referenced items will be always accessible to your readers!

When should you consider using it?

- ✦ To cite static digital content. Perma.cc doesn't work for videos or other dynamic content.
- ✦ If the web resource does not already have a persistent identifier (e.g., DOI). Otherwise, cite the existing identifier.
- ✦ To cite resources openly accessible on the web. Restricted access materials will be taken down.
